Requirements:

The concentration will consist of four graduate courses for a total of 12 hours:

- **F532: Public Practice in Folklore and Ethnomusicology (3 credits)**
- **One of our Practicum or laboratory courses - F802 TAI Practicum, F803 Practicum, F805 Laboratory in Public Practice, or F806 Museum Practicum in Folklore (Must be taken for 3 credits)**
- **2 approved elective courses** offered in the department (**6 credits**) See list on website or in handbook
